ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on the Water Master’s Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 and Recommendations for updating the Service List (“R&R”), docket no. 1588. Having reviewed the R&R, to which no objection was filed, the Court ORDERS as follows:

- (1) The R&R, docket no. 1588, is ADOPTED and APPROVED.
- (2) The changes to the Service List set forth in Attachment B to the Water Master’s Annual Report are APPROVED and shall be implemented.

1 (3) The Clerk is DIRECTED to update the Service List, with assistance from  
2 the Water Master, in a manner consistent with Attachment B.


3 (4) Pursuant to the Water Master's recommendation, the Court DIRECTS the  
4 Washington State Department of Ecology to mail, within thirty (30) days of the date of  
5 this Order, a notice to each Eligible Landowner explaining that, although fees are not  
6 being imposed this fiscal year, the rights, responsibilities, and obligations of the parties  
7 under the Settlement Agreement (also known as the Lummi Decree), docket nos. 1264-1  
8 through 1264-10, remain in full force and effect.

9 (5) The Clerk shall electronically file, and need not provide conventional  
10 service of, this Order.

11 (6) The Water Master shall post a copy of this Order on his website.

12 IT IS SO ORDERED.
